Alan received a complaint about the Resale Shop on Highway 12 about junk being piled up and they have started cleaning up. Alan received 2 bids for the paving. Vicki made a motion to accept the Rieth Riley bid for paving and Cathi seconded the motion and the motion was voted on and passed 2-0.

None


**Public Comments**
