

Town of Pines Public Budget Adoption Hearing for 2022

October 6, 2021

The Adoption Hearing for Budget 2022 of the Town of Pines was called to order at 6:00 PM. This meeting was held as an open meeting with restrictions, meeting was shared virtually via ZOOM for residents who are unable to come to the Hall.

James led us in the Pledge of Allegiance. In attendance were James Prast, Vicki Kuzio, Shelby Mashburn, Janice Lowe, and Phil Orlando.

The purpose of this meeting is to give a final review and vote to approve or deny the 2022 Budget.


Council reviews the Minutes from the 2022 Budget Public Hearing from September 15, 2021. Janice makes a motion to accept the Minutes, Vicki seconds. Janice votes Yes, Vicki votes yes, James votes yes. Carried 3-0.


Shelby leads off explaining that this is the Adoption Hearing for the 2022 Budget for the Town of Pines. Shelby asks Council to follow along with their highlighted sheets. No changes have been made or suggested from the Public Hearing for 2022 Budget from September 15, 2021. The numbers are as follows: The General Fund being at \$223,061, Local Road and Street Fund at \$15,049, Motor Vehicle and Highway Fund at \$80,828, Cumulative Capitol Improvement Fund \$1,143, and the Economic Development Income Tax CEDIT Fund at \$95,000.

Shelby asks if there are any questions or concerns. James also makes the reminder that these changes will not affect town residents and does not affect our current tax rate.

This completes the proposed changes made to the Budget for 2022. Janice makes a motion to accept the appropriations and tax rates for 2022, Vicki seconds this. Janice votes yes, Vicki votes yes, James votes yes. Budget approved and passed 3-0 for 2022.

As there was no further business, the meeting was adjourned at 6:10 P.M
