

Town of Pines Special Meeting

August 25, 2020

The special meeting of the Town of Pines, Town Council, was called to order at 6:30 PM.

This meeting is held for 2021 Budget and ADA Ordinance.

James led us in the Pledge of Allegiance. In attendance were, James Prast, Janice Lowe, Vicki Kuzio, Shelby Mashburn, and Philip Orlando.

Budget 2021

Shelby presented the Council and citizens with a current copy of the Town Appropriations, a Budget Estimate for 2021, and a Notice to Taxpayers with the suggested 2021 budget. This is an increase of \$31,550 from the 2020 Budget. Majority going towards new Town Needs such as the Truck and equipment as well as improvement of parks.

No Suggestions were made for changes to the budget of 2021.

The Council will revisit this for approval hearing on Friday September 4, 2020 at 6:30 PM.

ADA Ordinance

Janice presented the "Resolution NO 2020-08-02 for ADA Transition Plan for Town of Pines" to council. The listed changes needed to be made are Main Entry Clerks Window to be lowered to maximum height of 36" by 2022, Restroom to have at least one sink moved so there is a distance of 39" from the centerline of the toilet to the sink done by 2025, the microwave to be moved to a lower shelf by 2020. And the refrigerator to be replaced with more accessible doors by 2023.

Janice makes a motion to pass Resolution NO 20-08-02, carried 3-0.

As there was no further business, the meeting was adjourned at 6:45 P.M
